ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

At Crubenbeg Holiday Cottages we are committed to providing high quality self catering accommodation whilst also reducing the environmental impact of all our activities. We encourage our guests to help us in providing eco-friendly holiday accommodation through their actions while staying with us.

To contribute positively to our environment, Crubenbeg Holiday Cottages take the following actions:

- Low energy lighting is fitted where possible and practicable.
- Timers are fitted to all outdoor lighting.
- We shall replacing broken or worn-out appliances with energy efficient models.
- Glass, cans, paper, and cardboard. is collected for recycling.
- Wherever possible eco detergents / products are used in all cottages.
- Each cottage is thoroughly insulated, double glazed.
- Recycled paper is used in all of our stationery as well as for toilet tissues.
- Providing a natural pond / garden habitat which encourage wildlife.
- Promoting a “smoke outside” policy for the benefit of all our guests.
- Setting bi-annual environmental improvement objectives and targets (available to the public).

Guests can assist us implement our Environmental Policy by:

- Turning off lights and appliances when not in use to minimise energy usage.
- Turning off room heating if the cottage is too hot or if you leave the cottage.
- Our water comes from Cruben Beag Spring, so use water wisely.
- Do not flush anything but toilet paper.
- Shop locally – Kingussie Shops can supply most of your needs.
- Buy locally produced food - visit Cairngorms Farmers Market & Local Butcher.
- Buy items with out unnecessary packaging.
- Separate out your clean - Glass, Paper, Cans and Cardboard and place them in to the recycling
- Give us feedback and ideas on improving environmental performance using the feedback form in your cottage.
